and the Devon Historic Churches Trust

Every year we worry –the DHCT is dedicated to raising funds to enable us to give grants to our churches when they are faced with major repairs – and raising these funds is a considerable challenge for us all.

The trust has been able to give grants just short of £70,000 in the last financial year – and this is only possible because of the support given by so many at our annual fundraising event, the Devon Historic Churches Day, incorporating the Ride+Stride.

However, this is not the only way that the DHCT helps its parish churches. With this particular event 50% of funds raised are returned to our supporting churches, which for the 2012 event came to an additional £17,500.

The DHCT takes very seriously its commitment to help our churches and is actively considering new initiatives that can assist them, not only now, but for the future. An example of these strategies was the Viewpoynt audio tour promotion, which enabled four of our Devon churches to have a downloadable mobile phone App which will ensure that visitors have a truly memorable and enjoyable discovery of the churches special features and history.

Generous supporters from around the county delivered various fundraising events in support of the Trust through the year, and a special mention must go to General and Mrs Roland Notley, ably assisted by Monica Colvin and other friends who created a memorable and stimulating Handel's Messiah 'from Scratch' occasion at Oakford Church, raising £443 in the process.

The Devon Historic Churches Day each September is however our main income generator and one must never forget the fun that is had by so many in generating the highly valuable and very necessary funds. We are always rather cheered by the cheery enthusiasm of Alice May each year, who together with her husband Patrick and father Donald King take the Cadbury Deanery 'by storm' covering almost all of this considerable area by foot or bike, with incredible financial success.

The prize for initiative, from feedback received during 2012, must surely go to the party led by Sue Mumford, who together with a group of friends (and dogs!) set out from Brixton visiting churches, enjoying lunch and spectacular coastal paths and managing at the same time to 'walk on water' with a ferry journey across the River Yealm. A report of this particular adventure is being posted on the national Ride+Stride website to encourage other parties to be creative and of course enjoy a fun day with their friends at the same time.

Yet again in 2012 the Chulmleigh Group of churches led by one of the Trust's most active supporters the Rev. Roderick Withnell, provided the top amount raised in this event.

For me as the County Organiser of this annual event, my greatest challenge has always come in two parts. Firstly to overcome the misconception that to support the work of the DHCT and provide really vital income for our churches in their time of need, one needs to Ride a Bike! This could not be further from the truth – you can raise funds by any method you wish, or indeed send us a donation. The really, really important thing to remember is that our churches

need our grant aid and to deliver that we need your financial support by any means that appeals to you.

The second misconception is that there is a magic group of cyclists that will descend on your local church and give donations in the process. The Devon Historic Churches Day is very much a self-help event. We rely on those in our parishes or the wider community to create their own way of raising funds on this day, in a manner that appeals to them. We provide the publicity and promote the concept, but we do not provide groups of visitors – the support for each event or open church must be generated locally.

One of my aims is to ensure that all churches in the Diocese of Exeter are open on the second Saturday in September and doing something to generate funds; again as stressed before, 50% of all income raised goes immediately back to our supporting churches. **There are still iro 40% of our local churches who do not participate on this day, which is a great shame as the trust is dedicated to supporting the full 100%!**

In closing, one very important message that we would like to emphasise is that raising funds to support our work can be huge fun – and have the added bonus of drawing in the wider community to activities that will benefit each parish church in a wider context – so ‘think outside the box’, new ideas draw in new supporters.

I also offer our sincere thanks to all the parishes and individual supporters throughout Devon (and beyond!) who raise funds and send donations in support of the Trust, which is dedicated to funding repairs and maintenance to our glorious, but vulnerable Devon churches.
